

## 95 – Army group titles

### Statements in the book

95 fn. 14: ‘The titles of the three army groups varied slightly over time; the translated versions here have been adopted for clarity and conciseness.’

### Update and comment

These changes mainly affected Army Group Rupprecht, until the last day of the war when all were changed. The list here does not cover other army groups set up in 1918, principally Army Groups Gallwitz and Boehn, or those on the Eastern Front.

### Supporting evidence

#### Army Group Rupprecht

- Army Group Crown Prince Rupprecht of Bavaria [*Heeresgruppe Kronprinz Rupprecht von Bayern*]
- Army Group Crown Prince of Bavaria [*Heeresgruppe Kronprinz von Bayern* or *Heeresgruppe “Kronprinz von Bayern”*].
- Army Group Crown Prince Rupprecht [*Heeresgruppe Kronprinz Rupprecht*], from 1 March 1917.
- Army Group A [*Heeresgruppe A*], from 11 November 1918.

#### Army Group Crown Prince

- Army Group German Crown Prince [*Heeresgruppe Deutscher Kronprinz*]
- Army Group B [*Heeresgruppe B*], from 11 November 1918.

#### Army Group Albrecht

- Army Group Duke Albrecht [*Heeresgruppe Herzog Albrecht*]
- Army Group C [*Heeresgruppe C*], from 11 November 1918.
